1ST DAY

- 10am: Arrival at Portimão Airport – Pick-up by transfer
- 11.30pm: Early check-in (upon availability)
- TBC - Welcome drink at the Grand Beach Club
- TBC - Lunch at our Grand Beach Club with view over the mouth of Guadiana River
- Enjoy some quality time on our sunbeds at the Grand Beach Club

2ND DAY

- 9am: Transfer to a Oysterfarm (Olhão) and degustation of the Oysters – Ria Formosa –

GRAND HOUSE ALGARVE

The Revival of a Grand Dame

Once the Grande Dame of the Algarve, the beautifully restored boutique hotel Grand House lies on the waterfront of the Rio Guadiana, the river dividing Portugal from Spain. Paying homage to its roaring 1920s heyday – the décor is a flawless mix of art deco charm and contemporary chic.

The 26-room hideaway has been transformed into a showstopping retreat for aesthetes and the most hard-to-please urbanists, with jolly, welcoming staff and the hotel's charming Portuguese water dog. The hotel restaurant Grand Salon is straight out of a Fitzgerald novel. Every dish is worth the journey alone, from the octopus served in a puff of sweet potato foam to the ocean ravioli in verbena-Champagne foam and seaweed.

A few minutes away, where the Guadiana River meets the Atlantic Ocean, you find the hotel's Grand Beach Club with an infinity pool where you can while away the day eating pizza with figs, grilled octopus, watermelon salad or bruschetta with freshly caught tuna and watching the local fisherman as they come and go.
